

Dear Parent,

According to Pennsylvania Law, non-public school children are entitled to transportation to non-public schools as follows:

- A district which provides transportation for resident public school students must also make provisions for the transportation of resident non-public school students.
- Transportation for non-public schools must be provided to and from the non-public in which the student is enrolled, even if the non-public school is located outside the school district so long as the distance is not more than 10 miles beyond the district boundaries.
(Note: This distance may be in excess of ten (10) miles from the student's home.)
- A district may transport children who live along hazardous routes even though the children live within walking distance of the school.
